## **Introduction**

The Community Council has a statutory duty under section 67 of the Local Government and Elections (Wales) Act 2021 to make a plan setting out what it proposes to do to address the training needs of its councillors and staff.

The Community Council is committed to providing a good level of training for both its Councillors and staff to enable them to undertake their respective roles within the Community Council.

### Training aims

The Community Council's training aims are as follows:

- 1. To improve the understanding of the roles of its Councillors and staff and the powers available to community councils.
- 2. To ensure the Community Council can operate effectively following local elections and potential changes to the Council membership.
- 3. To ensure the Community Council can continue to operate during times of staff unavailability (eg holidays, sickness staff turnover etc).

### Training requirements

A more detailed assessment of Councillor training needs will be undertaken later in the financial year when new councillors have settled into their roles and have had time to determine their training needs.

In the meantime, there are core areas to address to ensure that Councillors have sufficient skills and understanding and these are as follows:

- Basic induction for councillors
- The Code of Conduct for members of local authorities in Wales
- Financial management and governance
